JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Equipping

- Arrange for/facilitate equipping opportunities for the student ministry volunteer base to be Trained, Affirmed, Given Feedback, Evaluated, Recognized, and continually Reflect on the ministry they are a part of.

• Communicate clearly and regularly with volunteers, students and parents (meetings, email, social media, videos, print, etc.) the vision, direction, and plans for CF Students Brentwood.

Leadership

- Oversee and lead all programming for CF Students Brentwood.
- Responsible for all budgets pertaining to CF Students Brentwood.
- Develop purposeful teaching and application for Middle School and High School students that contextualize evangelism and spiritual formation and regularly emphasize Jesus' love for God and others.
- Create healthy team dynamics with volunteers and leaders.
- Create team building opportunities for volunteers and leaders.
- Collaborate with CF Students Pastors at other Cornerstone campuses to ensure quality and consistency across multi-site.
