JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Caring for children's needs: changing diapers, feeding, assisting
 with potty-training, lifting children under 50lbs, etc. All duties
 involve ensuring that children have what they need during the
 time being cared for.
- Ensuring the supervision, safety and security of the children in your care: monitoring children on playground, being able to help children on and off play structures as needed, being able to move quickly in emergency situations, caring for minor wounds, escort children to and from restrooms.
- Teaching and ministering to children: teaching lesson, assisting with crafts, guiding children to multiple rooms for various classes, serving and supervising snack time, facilitate communication in a variety of ways.
- Maintains a clean, safe and unobstructed workplace: cleaning up after the children, making sure the room is sanitary, removing toys that have been broken, keeping cleaning products and other items (such as hot beverages) out of reach of children, reporting when equipment is damaged or unusable, etc.
- Organize and participate in recreational activities, such as games, crafts and outdoor play.
- These duties are not exclusive and with consideration of your job requirements and other skills, the job description can be added to or taken away from at the discretion of your immediate supervisor
- Create team building opportunities within worship community.
